

For Undergraduate Transfer Students and Nontraditional First-time Freshmen Students

Unless otherwise specified, to be considered for these scholarships and awards, you must submit the following:

- Completed and signed UT application for admission
 - \$40 nonrefundable admission application fee

 - Official high school transcripts or GED score and ACT/SAT scores (if taken) (not required for transfer students with 8 or more semester credit hours attempted)
 - Official transcripts from **ALL** colleges/universities attended
 - Proof of Phi Theta Kappa or other honor society membership (if applicable)
 - A completed 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is required for all awards with the exception of the Out-of-State Award and the Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship.**

UT ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

For Transfer Students and Nontraditional First-time Freshmen

- **Award:** Variable award amount ranging from \$1,000 - \$5,000 per year for full-time enrollment. Your award may vary based on merit and financial need.
- **Minimum Requirements for Transfer Students:** 3.0 higher education GPA; full-time enrollment.
- **Minimum Requirements for Nontraditional First-time Freshmen Students:** 3.0 high school GPA or 500 GED score; full-time enrollment.
- **Additional Documentation Required:** A FAFSA is required for scholarship consideration.
- **Renewal Requirements:** Minimum 3.0 GPA and 30 UT credit hours each academic year. In most instances, the maximum length for this award is eight consecutive semesters, not to exceed five consecutive calendar years or completion of an undergraduate degree, whichever comes first.

Note: This award is not stackable with the Out-of-State Award or the Prestige Transfer Scholarship.

To be considered for Admission Scholarships and Awards, students must first be admitted to The University of Toledo. Once admitted, students are automatically considered for Admission Scholarships and Awards. No separate scholarship application is required. Undergraduates with baccalaureate degrees are not eligible to receive admission scholarships.

OUT-OF-STATE AWARD

For Transfer Students and Nontraditional First-time Freshmen

- **Award:** \$8,800 per year for full-time enrollment.
- **Minimum Requirements:** Minimum higher education GPA of 2.75 (for transfer students) or high school GPA of 2.75 or 21 ACT or 980 SAT combined reading and math score or 500 GED (for nontraditional first-time freshmen); full-time enrollment.
- **Renewal Requirements:** Minimum 2.75 GPA and 30 UT credit hours each academic year. In most instances, the maximum length for this award is eight consecutive semesters, not to exceed five consecutive calendar years or completion of an undergraduate degree, whichever comes first.

Note: This award is not stackable with the UT Achievement Award or the Prestige Transfer Scholarship.



For Transfer Undergraduate Students and Nontraditional First-time Freshmen

PRESTIGE TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP

For Transfer Students

- **Award:** Variable award up to \$8,000 per year for full-time enrollment. This selective award will be given to top students transferring to UT based on higher education GPA, curriculum, and financial need. Preference is given to honor society members. Funding for this scholarship is limited, competitive, and selective. **To be considered for this scholarship, your UT application must be received by May 1, 2009.**
- **Minimum Requirements:** 3.5 higher education GPA; 30 or more semester hours of transfer credit; transferring from a 2-year or 4-year institution; full-time enrollment.
- **Additional Documentation Required:** The FAFSA is required for consideration. Proof of honor society membership (if applicable).
- **Renewal Requirements:** Minimum 3.0 GPA and 30 UT credit hours each academic year. In most instances, the maximum length for this award is four semesters, not to exceed two consecutive calendar years or completion of an undergraduate degree, whichever comes first.

*Note: This award is **not** stackable with the Out-of-State Award, the UT Achievement Award, or the Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship.*

PHI THETA KAPPA SCHOLARSHIP

For Transfer Students

- **Award:** \$1,000 per year.
- **Minimum Requirements:** 3.75 transfer GPA from the institution of Phi Theta Kappa induction; Phi Theta Kappa membership; full-time enrollment.
- **Additional Documentation Required:** Proof of Phi Theta Kappa membership.
- **Renewal Requirements:** Minimum 3.0 GPA and 30 UT credit hours each academic year. In most instances, the maximum length for this award is four semesters, not to exceed two consecutive calendar years or completion of an undergraduate degree, whichever comes first.

Note: This award may be stacked with the Out-of-State Award or the UT Achievement Award.
